TOP FIVE MOST IMPROVED PRIMARY SCHOOLS

The Entrance Public School is proud to share our recent achievements in State and National Assessments. As a school we continue to improve our results in Literacy and Numeracy.

The Daily Telegraph published the analysis that compared a five-year change in NAPLAN results from 2017 and 2021. It revealed the schools which have improved their Year 5 scores the most. It was calculated by each school's combined results for each NAPLAN subject in 2017 and compared these to the 2021 results.

TEPS have ranked third behind two small schools that have a much lower student enrolment in comparison to ours. The article highlighted collaborative education, dedicated teachers and evidence-based learning as key indicators for the significant improvement.



Saver Plus is an initiative of the Brotherhood of St Laurence and ANZ and delivered in partnership with local community organisations. The program is funded by ANZ and the Australian Government Department of Social Services.

What does it mean to be brave? Is it ever ok to break a promise?



We don't have the answers to these questions. In an ethics class we let the children discuss questions such as these and form their own views through respectful discussion with their peers.

Ethics classes support children to develop the skills they need to voice their opinions, consider the ideas of others and to make decisions based on evidence and reasoning rather than habit or peer pressure.

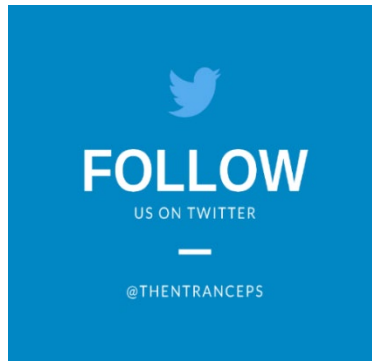
